NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

****Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.** <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp>

The MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Bitches in heat, injured, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.

Dogs must be on leash at all times (except during runs and in the warm-up area). **Please clean up after your dogs.**

CANCELLATION OF ENTRY: Entries cancelled before the trial closing date will be fully refunded. Cancellations after the trial closing date must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate as proof of health issues preventing entry or no refund will be issued

FACILITIES: This trial is being held outdoors on grass. There is ample crating space surrounding the ring area. Parking may be direct sun and competitors are advised to provide ample shade for dogs left in vehicles.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used in this trial: open tunnel, winged jumps, non-winged jumps, A-frame(rubberized), dog walk (rubberized), weave poles, and hoops.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER:

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

AS OF JANUARY-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes

SKILLED AND PROFICIENT: Dogs running in the Proficient division must jump at their designated height based on the NADAC Exhibitors Handbook. All dogs running in the Skilled division **MUST** jump 4" (one jump height) lower than their designated height.

MEASURING: Dogs jumping 20, Veteran Handlers & Juniors Handlers jumping 16, and dogs with permanent height cards do **NOT** need to be measured. Dogs entered in the **SKILLED** category and dogs listed on the Height Exemption List do NOT need to be measured. Measuring will be done at prior to runs beginning on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

CHECK-IN AT THE SCORING TABLE: Check-in will be at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday morning.

ORDER OF CLASSES: The tentative order of classes (subject to change) will be as listed on the cover page.

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET: Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring.

RUN ORDER: All events will be run in Elite – Open – Novice - Intro order.

Note: Regular classes will be run back-to-back – e.g., Elite/Elite, Open/Open, Novice/Novice, Intro/Intro

CLASS MOVE-UPS: Next-day move-ups will be possible for those classes being offered on both Saturday and Sundays. Please use the provided forms to help us manage your move ups effectively.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying scores. 1st to 6th placement ribbons will be awarded in all classes **except** Chances as it is a pass/fail class. “Title Completed” tags to add to rosettes will be available for titles attained during the weekend. Special rosettes for NATCH and Versatility NATCH are available for dogs earning these titles on the weekend.

FIRST DOG ON THE LINE: 6:00 P.M Friday Evening and 8:00 A.M Saturday and Sunday.

(SUBJECT TO CHANGE, CHECK WITH TRIAL ORGANIZERS AT CHECK-IN AND BEFORE LEAVING FOR THE DAY.)

Important Information

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers, directors, employees and members) and ScallyWaggs (Including ScallyWaggs officers, directors, employees, representatives and members) , and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we certify that I/we have knowledge of, and are familiar with, and agree to abide by, the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by NADAC for this trial. I/we certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.

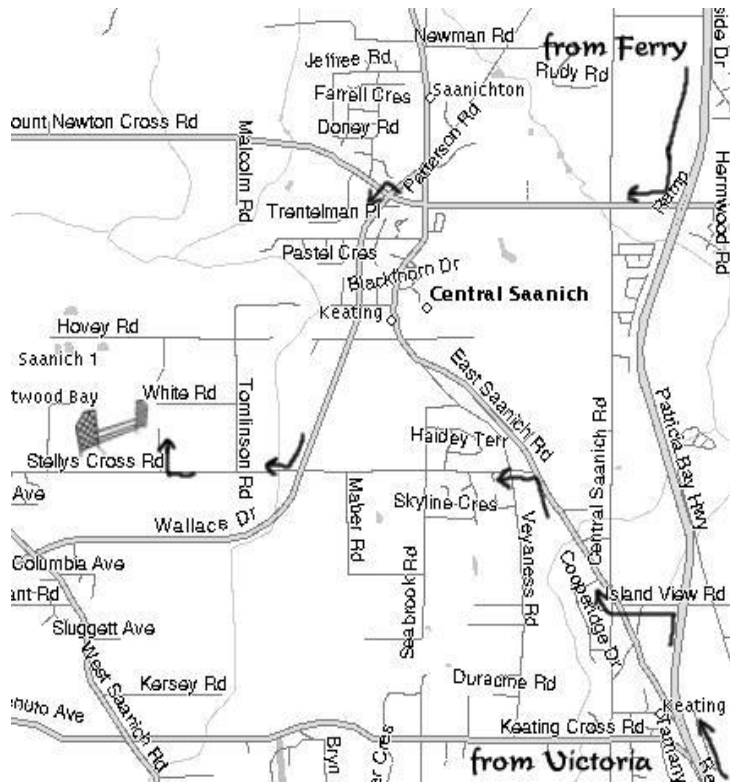
